# **EXTRA QUILT SIZES**

To make the quilt in different sizes, follow the Cutting and Quilt Assembly Instructions here and refer back to pages 1 - 2 for the Block Assembly.

#### **CRIB QUILT**

Finished Size: 30 1/2" x 30 1/2"

# **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS**

Four Fat Quarters
 Shop Fat Quarter Bundles at:
 <u>www.fatquartershop.com/fat-quarter-bundles</u>

- ½ yard accent fabric
- 1/2 yard binding
- 1 1/8 yards backing

#### **CUTTING**

- Cut four 18" x 20" rectangles into:
   2 8" squares 8 total (Fabric A)
   10 3" squares 40 total (Fabric B)
- Cut accent fabric into:
   32 3" squares (Fabric C)
- Cut binding fabric into: 4 - 2 1/2" x width of fabric strips (Fabric D)


# **QUILT ASSEMBLY:**

Make four Fat Quarter Four Patch Blocks.

Assemble Quilt Center.

Press rows in opposite directions.

Quilt Center should measure 30 1/2" x 30 1/2".



#### FINISHING:

Piece the Fabric D strips end to end for binding. Quilt and bind as desired.
