Threads of Friendship Quilt Show



Presented by the Patchers at the Lakeshore (PALS) Quilt Guild May 16 & 17, 2025

What you need to know to participate:

- Only active PALS members may enter quilts in the show
- PALS members may enter 2 quilts in the show, in addition to entering a challenge or bed turning quilt
- All quilts in the show must be registered, including those used for bed turning
- Photographs of all quilts in the show must be provided for registration. These do not need to be professional photos. <u>NOTE:</u> photos provided will not be returned.
- Registration forms are available online at www.palsquiltguild.org
 - Completed registration forms should be saved to the member's computer as a PDF form
 - When saving the completed form, members should use their last name and first initial in the saved file name. For example, Mary Smith's completed form would be saved as: Smith-M
 - The saved completed form and a photo of the quilt being registered should be mailed to palsquiltshow@gmail.com
 - Registration volunteers will confirm the receipt of the completed form and provide related information to the member after it has been processed
- Printed registration forms will be available at PALS 2025 March and April meetings.
- Hard copy completed registration forms may be turned in at the PALS 2025 March and April meetings.
- Ribbons will be awarded for first, second, and third place in each category and in the Challenge category. Ribbons will also be awarded for first, second, and third place for each quilting category.
- Ribbons will also be given for Viewer's Choice selection and Best of Show.
- Winners should contact the PALS Historian to have pictures taken with their award winning quilt.
- Registered quilts will be accepted at the Salvation Army (use gym door #4, off Graf St) <u>ONLY</u> at the following times:

Wednesday, May 14	5:00 PM to 7:00 PM
Thursday, May 15	9:00 AM to 11:00 AM

- Quilts should be folded with the top of the quilt outside and the lower right-hand corner facing up as you are looking at the folded quilt.
- Quilts may be picked up at the Salvation Army no less than one hour after the show closes (no earlier than 5:00 PM). Quilts will be available for pickup until 6:00 PM on Saturday, May 17.
- Only the person designated to be the pickup person on the completed registration form will be allowed to receive a quilt from the pickup area. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- PALS Quilt Guild and the Salvation Army are not responsible for loss, theft, or damage to any item displayed at the show. Normal precautions will be taken to protect belongings at all times. The Salvation Army will be securely locked when not in use. Quilt owners who desire insurance must provide it themselves.
- PALS Quilt Guild and The Salvation Army are not responsible for any quilt not picked up by 6 PM Saturday, May 17.
